

## ScienCon 2022 Terms and Conditions:

### §1 - General Rules

1.1. The organizer of ScienCon 2022 is the Polish Association of Physics Students (PSSF), which is the official National Committee of the International Association of Physics Students (IAPS) in Poland.

1.2. ScienCon 2022 is scheduled to start on 31 March 2022 at 12:00 p.m. and end on 3 April 2022 at 6:30 p.m. These hours are subject to change by the committee's decision. In this case, the participants will be informed about the change immediately.

1.3. All members of the organising committee, volunteers, mentors, lecturers and guests are obliged to comply with the regulations of the European Center for Geological Education and other regulations regarding presence on the premises of the University of Warsaw as well as follow the [IAPS Code of Conduct](#). 1.4. The official language of the event and the marathon is English.

### §2 - Terms of the participation

2.1. Only IAPS or PSSF members are eligible to participate in ScienCon 2022. We encourage you to contact us if you are interested in participating, but are not a member of IAPS or PSSF.

2.2. The condition for participation in the competition is registering through the given [registration form](#) and upon receiving confirmation of acceptance payment of the registration fee in the amount of 230 PLN within the time limit set by the organizing committee of ScienCon 2022.

2.3. Failure to pay the registration fee is equivalent to resignation from participation in the competition.

2.4. The registration fee covers transportation from University of Warsaw, Faculty of Physics to ECEG and back at the beginning and the end of the event as well as accommodation, meals, cultural and scientific programme. Arriving to Warsaw, along with required visas, COVID-19 tests or other legal requirements needs to be covered by the participant. Detailed information on the registration fee is available [here](#).

2.5. The ScienCon 2022 organizing committee reserves the right to refuse to refund the registration fee if the participant resigns from participation in the event.

### §3 - Rules of the competition

3.1. Participants agree to take active part in the scientific programme of ScienCon 2022, including the Marathon. The detailed rules of the marathon will be presented during ScienCon, but you can read more about it here:

3.2. The participants can not be relatives of mentors, organising committee or jury.

3.3. The participant must inform the committee about the dietary or nutritional requirements during the registration process. The committee cannot be held responsible for any health

problems in the event of failure to inform the committee about an appropriate diet. On the basis of information provided by the participants, the committee will make every effort to ensure that everyone receives food in accordance with their diet.

3.4. The committee members and volunteers are available to the participants 24 hours a day throughout the entire duration of ScienCon 2022 in cases of any situation requiring assistance.

3.5. For the duration of the competition, the principles of personal culture and respect for participants, committee members, volunteers, mentors, guests and employees of the University of Warsaw should be respected as detailed in the IAPS Code of Conduct.

3.6. In the event of non-compliance with the regulations by a participant, committee members have the right to admonish them and, in special cases, decide to exclude them from further participation in ScienCon 2022.

#### §4 - Covid - 19 Regulations

4.1. Everyone coming to ScienCon 2022 has to provide valid confirmation of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19. In case such confirmation is not available one needs to provide a negative result of the PCR test done during 48 hours before ScienCon 2022 starts.

4.2. The organising committee will follow all restrictions and guidelines provided by local authorities regarding the COVID-19 pandemic and will immediately inform all participants and guests about a possible case of COVID-19 if such a situation arises. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, regardless if you are vaccinated or not, you are asked to not come to ScienCon 2022 for the safety of all involved.

4.3. In cases new regulations placed by the local authorities will prevent the organizing committee from organizing ScienCon 2022 all efforts will be made to postpone the event and whenever needed and possible to refund the registration fees. Organising committee can not guarantee the full refund in case of sudden changes of regulations.

#### §5 - Final Rules
